The Lemhi Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) met in special session pursuant to recess of August 9, 2021 with Brett Barsalou, Chairman, Richard W. Snyder and Leah Madsen present via telephone. Also present was County Attorney Bruce Wither and County Clerk Brenda Armstrong.

Commissioner Barsalou had requested the special session to clarify the types of discussions that were appropriate for placement on the BOCC agenda. The Board has had a number of requests to discuss personnel and other administrative issues having to do with Steele Memorial Hospital during BOCC meetings.

The BOCC reviewed the Idaho Code sections related to county hospital boards and the statutory authority those boards have, including making personnel decisions. County Hospital Boards have specific statutory authority to make those decisions. The BOCC also discussed that they have the responsibility to set the agenda for BOCC meetings and that items on the agenda should be items over which the BOCC has the authority to make decisions and/or has authority.

Personnel, and other administrative issues that should be addressed by an appropriate appointed board, whether it is the Steele Memorial Medical Center Board, Lemhi County Fair Board or Lemhi County Airport Board.
