Salmon, Idaho

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to recess of the August 12, 2019 with Richard Snyder Chairman, Ken Miner and Brett Barsalou present. The minutes of the meeting of August 12, 2019 were approved.

IN THE MATTER OF DEPARTMENT HEADS

Lemhi County Weed Supervisor Sharayh Krantz updated the Commissioners on the Forest Service projects that weed spraying had been completed and the upcoming projects. They will be doing the Youth Bio Collections on August 28th. There will be spray days at Carmen and Tower this next month. Lemhi County Road and Bridge Supervisor Curt Rosin had reviewed the gravel bids that were opened on August 12th. The Notice of Award was signed by the board and the bid presented to Dahles- Red-E-Mix. He also reported that the Rattlesnake project will start mid month and the beams are going to Indian Creek to be set. Curt had a question about the turnaround point that they use on the E. Fork of Tower creek as to who will maintain it. They agreed for the time being R&B will maintain it. Supervisor Scott Duncan told the board he had a request from a pre-school teacher to have a field trip to the landfill. He was concerned about safety so the county policy was referred to that states no children are allowed out of vehicles so felt it best not to allow the field trip. On the expansion of the new cell that has been being worked on the engineer will be out after Labor Day to re-stake for finalization. They did have a dozer breakdown but hoping to have it up and running by the end of the week. Lemhi County Probation Officer Ton Fitte reported that positive Opioid testing is up. They have three juveniles at Department of Corrections. Himself and Treva will be attending the Juvenile Justice Conference in Fort Hall.

IN THE MATTER OF BUILDING PERMIT WAIVER

Owen Tarkalson was requesting a waiver of the building permit for his senior project. He would like to build a pavilion structure over the Fort Lemhi Wall. Ken Miner moved to approve and Brett Barsalou seconded. All were favor.

Ken Miner made motion and Brett Barsalou seconded to go into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(d) for a personnel issue. Roll call vote was held. Snyder – AYE: Barsalou – AYE: Miner – AYE

The board convened into regular session.

IN THE MATTER OF RIFLE RANGE EXPENSES

Lee Bingham and Robert Gruszecki had budget questions. In 2006 their budget was \$1500.00 and has since been reduced to \$1000.00 because of not having many expenses. They are now being required to pay for the chemical for the weed department to spray the rifle range and they are in need of their budget to be raised for FY 2021. They board ask them to submit their request to the County Clerk in May of 2020.

Ken Miner made motion and Brett Barsalou seconded to go into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(d) to hear indigent matters. Roll call vote was held. Snyder – AYE: Barsalou – AYE: Miner – AYE. Lemhi County Social Service Director Clint Morse presented the following case for consideration

and pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(b) a personnel issue was discussed. After convening in regular session, the following decisions were entered.

IN THE MATTER OF FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET HEARING

Chairman Snyder called the hearing to order and the budget was presented. No comments were received. Thereafter Ken Miner moved and Brett Barsalou seconded to approve the published tentative budget and adopted the Fiscal year 2020 budget.

RESOLUTION 2019-15

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEMHI COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 requires a public hearing upon budget appropriations and

WHEREAS, the taxing district's governing board has determined that the budget request does not exceed the allowed ad valorem budget, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners met at the County Commissioners Room at 200 Fulton Street on the 26th day of August, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. pursuant to the designated published time.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF LEMHI COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY RESOLVE:

That upon conclusion of said hearing the Lemhi County Board of County Commissioners determined and fixed the amount of the FY 2020 Budget in the amount of \$10,191,071.88, which is not greater than the tentative budget nor includes an amount to be raised by property taxes greater than the amount advertised.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each taxpayer owning improved property or business property in the County of Lemhi shall be assessed an annual fee of seventy dollars (\$73.00) per unit.
