That the Chairman of the Lemhi County County Commission is hereby authorized and directed to sign the statement of Acceptance of said Grant Offer (entitled Acceptance) on behalf of the County, the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the Chairman and to impress the official seal of the County on the aforesaid statement of Acceptance; and
