The Board of County Commissioners met in special session to open bids received previously advertised as required by Idaho Code Title 67, Chapter 28 requesting bids for the recycling of various types of scrap. Four companies submitted proposals on 1 to 4 categories:

- a. Western Metals Recycling
  - 1. Category 1 \$110.00 per ton
  - 2. Category 2 Market price
  - 3. Category 4 Batteries at .25 per pound
- b. Mill Creek Metals
  - 1. Category 1 \$93.00 per ton
  - 2. Category 2 Market price
  - 3. Category 4 Electronics at .05 per pound – Batteries at .23 per pound
- c. Pacific Recycling
  - 1. Category 1 \$85.00 per ton
  - 2. Category 2 Market price
  - 3. Category 3 \$10.00 per ton
  - 4. Category 4 Electronics at .03 per pound – Batteries at .24 per pound
- d. Interwest paper
  - 1. Category 3 \$28.00 per ton

The Board requested that Landfill Manager Scott Duncan review to see if bids are responsive.

**IN THE MATTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN HUD AND LEMHI COUNTY**

The Board reviewed and accepted a stipulated Judgment between Idaho Housing and Finance Association and Lemhi County Board of Commissioners relating to a foreclosure on an indigent lien.
