

October 25, 2021

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to recess of the October 12, 2021 with Brett Barsalou Chairman, Rick Snyder and Leah Madsen present. The minutes of the October 12, 2021 were approved.

IN THE MATTER OF DEPARTMENT HEADS

Russ Dalley from maintenance informed the commissioners he was ready for winter. He had checked on the grout around the brick at the courthouse and there are no cracks and they were still grout. He will start working on fixing them up. He will be replacing the key pads at the buildings. Commissioner Barsalou ask Russ about the retaining wall at the Brooklyn yard. It seems to have moved a little but it was prior to us purchasing the Brooklyn. Rob Schick and James Crawford from the airport reported they would be heading to Rigby to look at the plow truck they were possibly going to purchase. Idaho Power had come to the Leadore airport to check on the power for the lighting and the Beacon. There were previous lights along the runway so getting power should be simple. Commissioner Snyder asked about an airport directory so that the pilots would know where they could land. Commissioner Barsalou asked about who owns the airstrip in May. Rob said he would look into it. Scott Duncan Landfill Supervisor reported he was ready for winter and will need to extend the application process for a new hire.

Teresa Morton on behave of the Clerks Office presented a proposed Commissioner District Boundaries change. With the 2020 census being done this year we need to look at the population in each commissioner district. They need to be within 25% higher or lower of each other. She left the proposed map with them and they will look at it at the next meeting. Clint Morse website administrator gave the board some proposals for updating the county website to make it more efficient and user friendly. Jay Wiley, Scott Kesi and Trish Downton came before the board on fairground issues. They have some projects that need to be done including replacing the bucking shoots, announcers stand, stock pens, return alley and the red horse barn repairs. They had funds to cover the bucking shoots so those have been purchased. They have applied for a T-mobile grant to help with funding but have not heard anything on it yet. They were wondering if the county would help with funding and if they would need to have public workers contractors. The budget would have to be opened since this is out of the budget preparation time frame but there are funds to help. They were asked to get quotes and send them to Attorney Withers to look into the public workers requirements.

The quarterly Jail Inspection was completed.

IN THE MATTER OF EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

Leah Madsen moved and Rick Snyder seconded to go into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(b) for employee evaluations. Roll call vote was held. Barsalou – AYE: Snyder – AYE: Madsen – AYE.
