IN THE MATTER OF DEPARTMENT HEADS

Rob Schick and James Crawford were present for the airport board. James told the board that over the weekend they discovered an issue with the QT - credit card reader. The pump and the cc machine were not matching up so the machine was turned off. They were checking with QT to resolve the problem. Rob asked the board for authorization to spend an additional \$20,000.00 to cover the increase in the blade for the snowplow they were going to purchase. The board asked Clerk Armstrong if the funds were available. She responded they are available from their savings but the budget would need to be reopened for the expenditure. Rick Snyder moved and Brett Barsalou seconded to allow the additional funds to be expended. Rob reported that the airport at May Commissioner Barsalou had inquired about belonged to the State of Idaho and is located on BLM property. Rob came back and reported to the board that the credit card and QT was resolved. Shannon Williams, County Agent gave her monthly report for October. She reported they have been very busy getting 4-H kids enrolled. She extended an invitation to the board to attend the Extension Advisory Dinner on the 2nd of December. Shannon was excited about a new Go-Cart project this coming year. The fair board will be meeting tonight and Brett asked if they had been in contact with Attorney Wither on their projects.

Curt Rosin County Road and Bridge Supervisor reported they were still spot grading and replacing culverts. They have put a new French drain in on Panther Creek near Cobalt that was causing a bad wash out in the road. They are working on a grant for the Leadore area near Hawley Creek to replace the road topping. Commissioner Snyder asked about the road oil supply with Curt responding they have not had

any problems with the supply to date. The board also inquired about their ability to help the airport out this winter with snow plowing since their truck would not be available in time. Curt said they would help as needed. Landfill Supervisor Scott Duncan reported he had been trying to reach out to Linda Price with the BLM on the landfill expansion. Commissioner Barsalou said he would follow up with Linda. Scott stated we would need to contact an engineer at some point to start working on cell expansion no matter which direction we are to go with the landfill. When we start expanding we are going to need some upgraded equipment. Scott has been looking but has not had much luck. Good equipment is hard to find. With the absence of Kammy McFarland, County Treasurer Clerk Brenda Armstrong presented the FY2021 year-end Auditor/Treasurer joint report. She also presented a tentative October 2021 report.
